INFO SHEET REGARDING NURSERY SCHOOL FEES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF INNSBRUCK

• **Nursery School tariffs / "Free Nursery School"**

With the introduction of free nursery school the Municipality of Innsbruck has elaborated its tariff model. As from 2009/2010 no lump sum, or greatly reduced lump sums, is/are payable.

In future children aged 4 by 31.8.2009 pay no nursery school fee for supervision until 2 pm at the latest and Euro 29,00 monthly lump sum for a whole day; children under 4 years pay Euro 34,00 until 2 pm and Euro 59,00 monthly lump sum for a whole day. Euro 3,00 is payable per meal served.

100% outside supplement for non-Innsbruck children.

There are the following possibilities of arranging for a grant or assistance:

• **AMS child care assistance**

(Extract from the website www.ams.at/Service for those in search of work/arrangements for women/child supervision)

Who?

This support is available to women and men requiring a place for their child because they

- wish to take up work,
- wish to take part in a measure relevant to labour market policies (e.g. a course), or because
- their economic circumstances have fundamentally deteriorated despite being employed,
- essential changes in working hours require a new care facility/form,
- the carer hitherto active is no longer available.

Further requirements: the child must live in the joint household and be younger than 15 years of age (in the case of a handicapped child, younger than 19).

How long?

In the Tyrol assistance can be granted for up to 26 weeks per child, maximum duration of support 52 weeks.

What?

Day, half-day, hourly care in:

- nursery schools,
- care centres,
- children's crèches,
- children's groups
- with employed day carers (women/men),
- and with private individuals (except family members or au pairs).

How much?

The amount of child care assistance is scaled and depends on

- the gross (family) income,
- the care costs (not catering costs)

Where?

The assistance is linked to a consultation – with the competent adviser at the AMS Innsbruck, Schöpfstraße 5. Important: in due time, i.e. before the start of employment or of an AMS course and before the child has a place.

- **Child care grant by the Provincial Authority**

...for mothers/fathers who have to have their child cared for outside the house in order to go about their work, and who no longer receive assistance from the employment office (AMS).

Important: before making an application to the Provincial Family Department (Familienreferat) support must be applied for from the AMS.

The **application form** is available from the Familienreferat, Amt der Tiroler Landesregierung, Abteilung JUFF – Familienreferat, Michael-Gaismair-Straße 1, 6010 Innsbruck or for downloading under www.tirol.gv.at/Familienreferat.

The grant is tied to income limits. The net income is the basis for calculation. Detailed information is available from Herr Stefan Nagl, tel. ++43 (0)512/508-3567

Age of children in care

The grant is intended for the care of children up to their completed 14th year (14th birthday).

Claim requirements

- The parent/s applying and the child/ren must be Austrian or EU-citizens having their main residence in the Tyrol.
- The "child care grant" is only available to the parent/s applying in respect of those children for whom no child care benefit is drawn according to the Child Care Benefit Act, Fed. Law Gazette I no. 103/2001 in the version of the Act Fed. Law Gazette I no. 20/2002.
- The "child care grant" is not available, if the possibility exists for the granting of similar aid on the part of the employment office (AMS) or another facility (e.g. Social Security Office).
